

Attendance Awareness Month



The Office of School Leadership and Performance is calling all schools to encourage student participation in the **Show Up M-DCPS Attendance Contest**. All students attending Miami-Dade County Public Schools are eligible to participate. Posters/videos will be judged on how well they address the theme, the quality of the design and student creativity.

K-5 Students:

- Submit a poster highlighting “Why Attendance Matters” or “Why Attending School is Cool”.
- Design a poster on an 8.5 inch x 11 inch sheet of paper that speaks to the theme.
- Schools should select the winning poster and complete the submission form via:

- Posters must be received by Friday, September 27, 2024, to be eligible to win.

Awards:

- All winners’ photos will be shared on the district’s social media and web pages.
- District video/poster winners’ (first, second, third place) entries will be shared on the district’s social media and web pages.
- Poster winners’ entries will be made into a banner to be displayed at winners’ schools.
- One poster winner per voting district.

6-12th Students or Student Teams:

- Create a 2-minute max video highlighting “Why Attendance Matters” or “Why Attending School is Cool”.
- Videos can be in any format: music videos, skits, documentaries, spoken poem, commercials or PSA, etc.
- One submission per school, only.
- Teams may consist of more than one student and must include a lead teacher.
